The general purpose financial statements are prepared in accordance with the modified cash basis of accounting, which is a basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

If the omitted disclosures were included in the general purpose financial statements, they might influence the user's conclusions about the Fire Protection District's assets, liabilities, fund balance, revenues, and expenses. Accordingly, these general purpose financial statements are not designed for those who are not informed about such matters.
